REVISION 2011

The TFEU (commonly referred to as the Treaty of Rome) has been renumbered *twice* now. You need to be aware of this, as otherwise it may become confusing when looking at cases (particularly older ones) which refer to one of the two old numbering systems.

From the **1950s** through to the Treaty of Amsterdam (which came into force on **1 May 1999**), the original numbering system was used. Any cases between these times will refer to the original numbers of the Treaty of Rome.

The Amsterdam Treaty renumbered the original Treaty of Rome because with all the amendments that had occurred in over 50 years, the numbering had become untidy and complicated. This was effective from **May 1999** to **December 2009**.

On **1 December 2009**, the Lisbon Treaty renumbered the Treaty of Rome again, for much the same reason.

The table opposite gives all three versions of the Treaty numbers:
